

## 2015 Recommended Energy Code with Amendment

A **resolution** of the **Central Iowa Code Consortium** recommending adoption the 2015 edition of the *International Energy Conservation Code*, regulating the minimum energy conservation requirements for new buildings.

The **Executive Committee** of the **Central Iowa Code Consortium** does ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** That a certain document, being marked and designated as the *International Energy Conservation Code*, 2015 edition, as published by the International Code Council, be and is hereby recommended as the Energy Code of the participating communities of the **Central Iowa Code Consortium**, for regulating energy conservation requirements for all aspects of energy uses in both commercial and residential construction including heating and ventilating, lighting water heating and power usage for appliances and building systems as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said Energy Code are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this legislation, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

**Section 2.** That the following sections are hereby revised:

Section 408.2 Insert: **The Commissioning Agent shall be in no way affiliated with the project's design, installation or sale of products, to avoid any conflict of interest. The Commissioning Agent shall be accredited by an industry-recognized certification program, to be determined by the AHJ.**

Modify Code Section: C408.2

Replace with the following language:

**C408.2 Mechanical systems and service water-heating systems commissioning and completion requirements.** Prior to the final mechanical and plumbing inspections, the *registered design professional* or *approved agency* shall provide evidence of mechanical systems *commissioning* and completion in accordance with the provisions of this section. The Commissioning Agent shall be in no way affiliated with the project's design, installation or sale of products, to avoid any conflict of interest. The Commissioning Agent shall be accredited by an industry-recognized certification program, to be determined by the AHJ.
