February is Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month (TDVAM), a national effort focused on advocacy and education to prevent dating violence before it starts, and the Iowa Coalition Against Domestic Violence (ICADV) wants to raise awareness by hosting a **What is Love contest!**

Contest Details

Who: Iowa high school students, ages 14-18

Date: Entries can be submitted February 8-24, 2020

What: Participants can submit a piece of artwork that expresses their idea of “What is Love?” Entries can be submitted into two categories:

- 2D Art – painting, photography, short essay, graphic design, pottery, drawing
- Video (*a maximum of 3 minutes in length*) – dance, poem, music, skit, song

All entries must be original pieces by the participant and submitted in a digital format at www.icadv.org.

Prize: Three entries in each of the two categories will receive a cash prize. First place will be \$200 and the second and third runner up will each receive \$50. All participants will have their artwork highlighted on ICADV’s digital and print platforms, awareness campaigns and a variety of promotional materials.

Why: Not only is this a fun way to share your creative talents, but it is a great way to raise awareness about Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month.
